### Admission Process

- 1 Obtain application packet from the Program Director.
  - 2 Submit necessary information, including application, reference letters and academic data to the Program Director no later than February 1.
  - 3 If admission requirements are met, applicants will be notified to arrange a personal interview during the months of October through February.
  - 4 Acceptance of applicants is based on a point system. The School Admission Committee considers each applicant based upon a documented point scale, with reference to certain applicant characteristics and qualifications.
  - 5 The Admissions Committee will select the applicants who rank the highest in our applicant pool. The student will be notified no later than March 1st.
- The qualified applicant should:
- 1 Be in good health and meet "technical standards" appropriate to radiologic technology as set forth by the school
  - 2 Be a high school graduate or have GED.
  - 3 Have taken the ACT examination within the last five years.
  - 4 Show emphasis in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Math.
  - 5 Have an overall GPA 2.5 or higher.

## Emergency Medical Technician

### Costs/Enrollment

#### EMT-Basic

Tuition, Books, Fees..... \$ 375

Limited to 30 students. Applicants must be 18 years old.

#### EMT-Paramedic

Tuition, Books, Fees..... \$ 4,250

Limited to 20 students. Applicants must be 18 and a certified EMT. One class per year.

Admission requirements include:

- ◇ High School diploma or equivalent
- ◇ Certification as an EMT-B, EMT-I or EMT-SS
- ◇ Entrance Exam/Admission Interview
