Programs Offered

Cosmetology: Upon completion of the course you will receive a diploma of 2,100 hours in cosmetology, which entitles you to take the state board test at the South Dakota Cosmetology Commission in Pierre, SD. Upon passing that test you will become a South Dakota Licensed Cosmetologist. Our program includes advanced classes in artificial nails, specialty facials, body waxing, hair extensions, hair cutting, coloring and styling.

Esthetics: Upon completion of the course of 600 hours you will receive a diploma, which entitles you to take the state board exam. Upon passing you will become a state licensed esthetician. You will be taught using the most up-to-date curriculum available. You will receive advanced training in facials, facial peels, body wraps, body waxing, certified in microdermabrasion and make-up techniques.

Massage: You will receive a diploma certifying your status as a certified message therapist, when all minimum course requirements are complete and monies due the Academy are paid. South Dakota does require licensing and upon completion you will be eligible for application to National Certification Board of Therapeutic Massage & Body Works for testing and certification. This six-month program will expose you to a wide variety of modalities to start your career in massage.

Nail Technology: Upon completion of the course of 400 hours you will receive a diploma, which entitles you to take the state board testing. Upon passing you will become a state licensed nail tech. You will be taught using the most up-to-date curriculum available being trained to apply four various nail applications and advanced training in electric nail files.
