- Completed application and \$20 fee. Applicants may apply online at www.lakeareatech.edu.
- Official high school transcript or GED scores.
- ACT score or campus entrance test score.
- Official college transcripts, if applicable.
- OTA & PTA applicants must also submit a written essay. See website for details.

Upon acceptance, a \$25 acceptance fee and \$125 tuition deposit (\$150 total) is required to secure the applicant's position in the program.

Early applications are recommended for students who wish to secure admittance at the most desirable time.
