Acceptance Guidelines

USF offers varying levels of acceptance based on academic achievement in high school/college. For full acceptance with no restrictions, prospective students must meet two of the following:

1. A minimum composite score of 19 on the ACT or 910 on the SAT.
2. Upper 50% of HS graduating class
3. HS CGPA of 2.5

Application Procedures

1. Submit a completed on-line or hardcopy application with the required \$25 application fee.
2. Have official HS transcript and ACT/SAT score sent directly to the USF Admissions Office
3. Have transcripts for any post-high school coursework sent directly to the USF Admissions office.
