Acceptance Guidelines

USF offers varying levels of acceptance based on academic achievement in high school/college. For full acceptance with no restrictions, prospective students should achieve a minimum 2.8 high school GPA and a composite ACT score of at least 20. USF also expects students to complete a college preparatory high school curriculum. Students who do not meet these criteria may still be considered for admission and are encouraged to apply.

Application Procedures

1. Submit your application on-line and the application fee is waived or submit the hardcopy application with the required \$25 application fee.
2. Have official HS transcript and ACT/ SAT score sent directly to the USF Admissions Office
3. Have transcripts for any post-high school coursework sent directly to the USF Admissions office.
