Admission Policy

Admittance to BHSU is based on the academic and personal qualifications of the applicant in accordance with SD Board of Regents regulations. Students must have completed the following core with at least a 2.0 GPA:

- 4 years of English
- 3 years of social studies
- 3 years of math (algebra or advanced)
- 3 years of lab science
- 1 year of fine arts

High school graduates must also graduate in the top 60% of their class or have an overall 2.6 GPA, or have an ACT composite score of 18 or better.

Admission Procedures

Applicants should submit an application for admission, \$20 application fee, ACT scores and a high school transcript. Upon acceptance, a Residence Life and medical immunization form will be sent out to be completed prior to class registration.
